This Buoyant Orange Smoke is suitable for use daylight distress signalling.

This Smoke Signal has a simple ignition device to pull off ignition cord on a top, and is capable of function on oil covered water.

## DIMENSIONS & WEIGHT

85mm diameter, 140mm long, 500g

## APPLICATIONS:

For use on small crafts and in ship's life-boats and life-rafts.


PERFORMANCE: Produces dense orange smoke for 3 minutes.

## EFFECTIVE PERIOD:

3 Years and 6 Months

## OPERATION

- (1) Remove adhesive tape on top.
- (2) Hold ignition cord firmly. Pull sharply in vertical direction Keep face and body away from emission point. After 2 seconds, it begins to smoke.
- (3) Throw signal into water downwind.



CAUTION Do not point at people. Do not use signal except in distress.
